
THE BERNARD SHAW PRIZE 2018



A triennial prize (£2,000) for translations into English of full length Swedish language works of literary merit and general interest

ENTRY DEADLINE: 28 FEBRUARY 2018

The Bernard Shaw Prize for the translation of Swedish into English was established in 1991 and is named after the author and dramatist, part of whose Nobel Prize supported a foundation for 'the promotion and diffusion of knowledge and appreciation of the literature and art of Sweden in the British Islands'. The prize is generously sponsored by the Anglo-Swedish Literary Foundation, the Swedish Embassy and Arts Council England

CRITERIA FOR ENTRY

- The original can be of any period.
- The translation must have been first published in the UK during 2015-2017 inclusive.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The decision of the judges is final and they reserve the right not to award the Prize if, in their opinion, no works entered reach a sufficiently high standard. Judges may call in books if they so wish.
